



Immunisation Support

Immunisation is an integral part of general practice. The Commonwealth Government's General Practice Immunisation Incentives (GPII) has assisted GPs as primary immunisation providers through a variety of incentives. These include incentives to GPs for providing immunisation services and for having at least 90% of their young patients fully immunised.

GP Network Support

From cold chain management to data cleansing, the General Practice Development Team can help practices ensure protocols and procedures are in place to improve immunisation rates.

This support is available through one to one visits in your Practice, telephone support and education events run throughout the year.

A variety of worksheets and an Immunisation Manual are also available for GP members and practice staff.

The manual includes:

- Current and previous schedule
- Explanation of the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register
- Protocols for immunisation
- Cold chain storage
- Anaphylaxis shock - signs, symptoms and management
- How to record vaccinations
- How to improve your practices rates
